



International Transfer Card from USA Hockey

Please be advised that USA Hockey is very willing to co-operate in the processing of IIHF transfer cards that will allow US players to play for the European Clubs.

However, please be aware that upon our issuing a transfer card on behalf of the specific player to your club, you are agreeing to the IIHF rules and regulations as outlined in the International Transfer Regulations section 10 (Release of a Player for National Team Games).

It is imperative that club teams understand that USA Hockey may select players from any team and it is that club's responsibility to release the player. The club team is obligated to do so as outlined in the IIHF rules and regulations in International Transfers.

- 10.1 Any club that has registered a player who is eligible under IIHF By-laws to play for the national team of a member national association must, in the event that he is selected for one of its representative teams, release him to the member national association for which team he is eligible to play, irrespective of age and in accordance with the IIHF International Transfer Regulations, which in this respect includes all players whether transferred or not.

- 10.5 The Club with which the summoned player is registered shall be responsible for his insurance coverage against sickness and accident during the entire period of his release including insurance for injury sustained in the international matches for which he is released.

Prior to issuing the player card, the respective club and player must sign this document stating that they fully understand that the respective player will be made available to USA Hockey at any time that the player may be required to play for a USA National Team.
